California Achieving a Better Life Experience (CalABLE) is a new program that will allow people with disabilities to establish tax-advantaged savings accounts with the ability to save up to \$14,000 (currently) per year and up to \$100,000 without losing SSI. In California, beneficiaries will also have the ability to save beyond the \$100,000 (up to \$475,000) and still participate in Medi-Cal and other vital public benefits programs.

To be eligible, a person:

- Must be disabled before age 26 AND
- Currently receiving, or eligible for, SSI/SSDI OR
- Has been diagnosed by a qualified physician with a physical or mental disability resulting in marked and severe functional limitations that is expected to last no less than 12 months (self-certification)
