

CUMULATIVE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC DEBT ISSUANCE (IN BILLIONS)¹







¹ California Government Code Section 8855(i) stated that RPDIs must be submitted no later than 30 days prior to issuance.

² Under California Government Code Section 8855(j), "The issuer of any debt issue of state or local government, not later than 21 days after the sale of the debt, shall submit a report of final sale to the commission by any method approved by the commission. A copy of the final official statement for the issue shall accompany the report of final sale. The Commission may require information to be submitted in the report of final sale that is considered appropriate."

Mandatory Electronic Reporting

Time is running out! Effective January 1, 2016, CDIAC will no longer accept reports of proposed debt issuance or reports of final sale submitted by mail or as an attachment to an email. Government Code Sections 8855(i) and 8855(j) require issuers of any debt issue to submit reports to the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission (CDIAC) prior to and after the sale of the debt.¹ Beginning January 1, 2016, all reports must be filed electronically using CDIAC's website at www.treasurer. ca.gov/cdiac/reporting.asp. Please contact the Data Unit by email at CDIACIssuance@treasurer.ca.gov or by phone at 916-653-3269 if you have any questions, concerns, or comments about our reporting forms or if you are experiencing difficulty submitting reports using CDIAC's online portal. CDIAC will work to address technical and procedural problems to provide for an easy transition to electronic reporting.

¹ Issuers are required to report proposed issuance no later than 30 days prior to the issue and to report issued debt no later than 21 days after the sale.

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DebtWatch Launched

Since 1984, CDIAC has been collecting data on the issuance of debt by state and local government entities. CDIAC's Debt Issuance Database holds nearly three millions fields of data on nearly 52,000 financings. Until last month, the data was available to the public in "pdf" format as either the *Debt Line* newsletter or other periodic reports or in Excel format dowloadable from the CDIAC website.

On November 17, 2015, State Treasurer John Chiang, as part of his ongoing efforts to promote transparency in government, unveiled <u>DebtWatch</u>, a new open data website built using CDIAC's Debt Issuance Database. DebtWatch features intuitive, visual tools that make it easier for the general public to look up data about their community, download raw numbers, create charts and make comparisons among issuers.

"What I've done with DebtWatch is brought the data out of the shadows and presented it in an easy-to-use, more accessible way using graphics and tools that permit slicing and dicing," said Chiang. "We want to engage a broad audience. We have not left anyone out, from Jane Q. Public looking for an intuitive interface, to sophisticated data experts seeking raw data for their own research."

There are three methods to access debt issuance data on DebtWatch. The first method is through the "Debt Wheel", a user interface that groups debt issuance into eight issuer categories including cities, counties, K-14, state, UC / CSU, Mello-Roos, JPAs, and special districts. Or, if you'd prefer to narrow the focus of your query to a particular county, an intuitive state map allows a user to preselect only data from issuers within a specific county's boundaries. Finally, if you would rather have a complete download of all 52,000 records, DebtWatch offers "Explore All Data".

DebtWatch also includes the full complement of CDIAC's tax and bond election data and the most current Mello-Roos yearly fiscal status data. In addition, cost of issuance data is made fully available for the first time.

The data that powers DebtWatch is extracted from the CDIAC Database and refreshed every month. This gives CDIAC the opportunity to make improvements, additions, and corrections and have the changes, even of debt issued years ago, reflected monthly.

Site improvements are already being planned to bring added functionality and features, which will be rolled out incrementally. User feedback is important and will aide in creating and prioritizing these changes. UPDATES TO OCTOBER

- 21 Internal Revenue Service (IRS) released the private activity bond (PAB) volume caps for 2016.
- 26 The Treasury Department and IRS have released final allocation and accounting rules that will help in administering public-private partnerships (P3s).

UPDATES TO NOVEMBER

3 MSRB filed with the SEC new Rule A-18 on mandatory participation in business continuity and disaster recovery testing. The Rule went into effect upon filing and requires certain brokers, dealers, and municipal advisors to participate in business continuity and disaster recovery plans testing in connection with the SEC's Regulation Systems Compliance and Integrity.

- SRB received approval from the SEC to limit gifts given by municipal advisors in their professional capacity advising municipalities. The SEC also approved related recordkeeping requirements. The amendments to Rule G-20 become effective on May 6, 2016.
- 9 MSRB filed with the SEC a proposed amendment to Rule G-42 regarding core duties of municipal advisors.
- **12** MSRB published a *Compliance Advisory for Municipal Advisors* to assist municipal advisors in under-

standing and implementing regulatory changes.

DECEMBER

- 7 MSRB Rule G-18 on best execution in municipal securities goes into effect.
- **10** Comments are due to MSRB on changes to facilitate shortening the securities settlement cycle, affecting Rules G-12 and G-15.
- **11** Comments are due to MSRB on Notice 2015-16 regarding a confirmation disclosure proposal.
- **15** The requirements of GASB Statement No. 77, *Tax Abatement Disclosures*, are effective for reporting periods beginning after this date.
