RESULTS OF THE 2014 GENERAL ELECTION

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INTRODUCTION

Constitutional and statutory provisions require voters to authorize general obligation (GO) bonds issued by state and local governments. For bonds issued by the state, the authorization must be made through a statewide election. Local bonds must be approved by voters within the jurisdiction authorizing the bond. The State and local governments must also seek voter approval for levies of certain revenue exactions and taxes. For both State and local measures, the voter approval threshold depends on the type and purpose of the bond or tax (see Figure 1).

After each statewide election, the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission (CDIAC) publishes a statistical summary and review of bond and tax measures appearing on state and local ballots. This report, the 29th in the series, summarizes the results of bond and tax measures on the November 4, 2014 General Election ballot. This report also contains appendices which summarize the measures by county, region, type of tax/debt and purpose.

NOVEMBER 2014 GENERAL ELECTION RESULTS

SUMMARY

- **TOTAL MEASURES.** Voters considered 254 local fiscal measures and one State GO bond measure (Figure 2).
- **APPROVED MEASURES.** Voters approved 180 (70.6 percent) measures: one state GO bond measure (Proposition 1), 94 local GO bond measures, 50 general tax measures, 33 special tax measures, one revenue bond measure, and one water charge measure.
- **PASSAGE RATES.** Excluding the revenue bond measure and water charge measure, GO bond and general tax measures had the highest approval ratios (Figure 2).

**Proposition 1: Water Bond.
Funding for Water Quality, Supply,
Treatment, and Storage Projects.**

This GO bond measure authorizes \$7.545 billion in general obligation bonds for state water supply infrastructure projects, including surface and groundwater storage, ecosystem and watershed protection and restoration, and drinking water protection. The measure garnered approximately 67.1 percent of the vote, easily surpassing the majority vote required to pass.

**GENERAL OBLIGATION
BOND MEASURES**

- **STRONG SUPPORT FOR GO BOND MEASURES.** Voters approved 80.5 percent of these measures including a State GO bond measure for water (Figure 3).
- **VOLUME OF APPROVED MEASURES.** Voters approved \$17.6 billion in GO bond measures.
- **K-12 EDUCATIONAL FOCUS.** 85.6 percent of the GO bond measures were for K-12 education (Figure 4).
- **STRONG SUPPORT FOR K-12 EDUCATIONAL GO BONDS.** Voters approved 83.2 percent of K-12 education GO bond measures.

TAX MEASURES

- **SUPPORT FOR TAX MEASURES.** Voters approved nearly 62 percent of tax measures (Figure 5).
- **SUPPORT FOR GENERAL TAX MEASURES.** General tax measures received 62.5 percent voter approval.
- **MAJORITY VS. TWO-THIRDS VOTING REQUIREMENT.** The general and miscellaneous tax measures only needed a majority of the vote to pass. If these measures had a two-thirds voting requirement, only 26.2 percent would have passed.

Special tax measures, which require two-thirds voter approval to pass, received almost as much voter support as general tax measures (60 percent passage rate). If these measures

required a majority vote, 87.3 percent of the measures would have passed.

- **WATER RATE CHARGE MEASURE.** This measure proposed to continue a supplemental charge of \$1.50 per meter to minimum water rates to fund a mosquito abatement program. This measure received great voter support (75.6 percent).
- **PURPOSE OF TAXES.** Most of the tax measures were for general government purposes (58.8 percent), followed by public health and safety purposes, such as fire protection, emergency medical services, and police services (17.6 percent). The remaining measures were for miscellaneous projects, K-12 education, and capital improvements (Figure 6).

RESULTS BY REGION

The election results also are divided into five regions: Bay Area, Central Valley, Los Angeles, San Diego/Inland Empire, and Other (Figure 7).

Figure 8 shows the number and percentage of measures that were approved by region.

- **APPROVED MEASURES.** Bay Area Region voters were presented with the most measures (74) and they approved the most measures (61). Other than “multiple” regions, San Diego/Inland Empire region voters approved the least measures (22).
- **PASSAGE RATES.** The Bay Area Region also had the highest passage for GO bond and tax measures (82.4 percent). The San Diego/Inland Empire had the lowest passage rate (59.5 percent).

COMPARISON OF THE 2012 AND 2014 GENERAL ELECTIONS

- **COMPARATIVE PASSAGE RATES.** The passage rate of bond and tax measures during the 2014 General Election (70.6 percent) was lower than that of the 2012 General Election passage rate (74.4 percent).
- **COMPARATIVE NUMBER OF APPROVED MEASURES.** The number of voter approved measures (180) is the same for 2014 and 2012.
- **GENERAL GOVERNMENT MEASURE PASSAGE RATES.** General government measures had a lower passage rate in 2014 (62.5 percent) than 2012 (79.1 percent).
- **SPECIAL TAX MEASURE PASSAGE RATES.** The passage rate for special tax measures was higher in 2014 (60.0 percent) than 2012 (53.2 percent).
- **REGIONAL PASSAGE RATES.** The Bay Area region had the highest passage rate in 2014 (82.4 percent) and the Los Angeles region had the highest passage rate in 2012 (80.4 percent).
- **PASSAGE RATES BY PURPOSE.** Education had the highest passage rate in 2014 (82.6 percent) and 2012 (82.4 percent).
- **COMPARATIVE NUMBER OF PROPOSED LOCAL MEASURES.** In both elections, the highest

percentage of proposed local measures was for educational use (47.4 percent in 2014 and 54.1 percent in 2012). The lowest percentage of proposed local measures was for capital improvements in both elections (4.3 percent in 2014 and 2.5 percent in 2012).

Figure 9 provides a summary of the passage requirements for the bond and tax measures appearing on the 2012 General Election and the 2014 General Election ballots.

Figure 10 provides a summary of the types of bond and tax measures on the General Election ballots.

A summary of votes by regions is provided in Figure 11.

Figure 12 summarizes the types of projects appearing on the General Election ballots. Projects that comprise the miscellaneous category include projects such as wetlands maintenance, animal care, open space conservation and protection, clean energy jobs, firefighter facilities, police services, library, parks and recreation, youth crime prevention programs, street improvements, removal/disposal of abandoned/wrecked vehicles, clean water and natural flood protection program, swimming pool maintenance, performing arts center, transportation, fairground operations, zoo maintenance, and mosquito abatement.

SUMMARY

The passage rate of bond and tax measures from the 2012 General Election to the 2014 General Election decreased 3.8 percent while the number of proposed ballot measures increased 5.1 percent. In the 2012 and the 2014 elections, education measures received significant voter approval;

however, miscellaneous measures received the least voter support. Ninety-three (93) percent of education measures required 55 percent voter approval whereas all of the miscellaneous measures required two-thirds voter approval. Regionally, measures on the ballots in Los Angeles and the Bay Area received the greatest voter support in the last two statewide general elections.
