## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that on Friday, April 11, 2014, a public hearing as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the "Code") will be held by the California Health Facilities Financing Authority (the "Authority") with respect to the proposed issuance by the Authority of its revenue bonds in one or more series in an amount not to exceed \$200,000,000 (the "Bonds"). The proceeds of the Bonds will be used by Lucile Salter Packard Children's Hospital at Stanford (the "Borrower") to finance certain costs of the expansion of its existing hospital facilities located at 725 Welch Road, Palo Alto, California 94304. The expansion will include construction, equipment, furnishings and land improvements and will increase the size of the existing hospital facilities by approximately 521,000 square feet. The expansion is being constructed in Palo Alto, California in the area bounded by Welch Road and Quarry Road adjacent to the Borrower's existing hospital facilities. Proceeds of the Bonds may also be applied to pay certain expenses incurred in connection with the issuance of the Bonds. The facilities described above are or will be owned and operated by the Borrower, a nonprofit public benefit corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of California and an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

The hearing will commence at 10:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, and will be held in Suite 590, 915 Capitol Mall, Sacramento, California.
