

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, that a public hearing will be held before the Executive Director of the California Pollution Control Financing Authority (the "Authority") or a designee on Thursday, March 10, 2016, at 10:00 a.m. or as soon thereafter as such matters may be heard, in Room 440 of 915 Capitol Mall, Sacramento, California, on the proposed issuance pursuant to a plan of financing, of one or more series of revenue notes by the Authority in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$8,250,000 (the "Notes").

The proceeds of the Notes are intended to finance or refinance the acquisition, construction, improvement, renovation, rehabilitation and/or installation of equipment, including trucks, front-loaders and side-loaders or other rolling stock, and residential carts, for the collection, transport, handling, processing and/or recycling of solid wastes and to pay associated costs of the financing. All financed assets are owned or will be owned and/or operated by Mottra Corporation, CalMet Services, Inc. and/or an affiliate thereof (the "Company"). The rolling stock will be housed at 7201 and 7202 Petterson Lane, Paramount CA 90723, in the County of Los Angeles. The residential carts will be located at the sites of the Company's customers in the City of Downey, California.

Notice is further given that at said hearing, all proponents and opponents of the above referenced facilities or the possible financing will have an opportunity to be heard on the question as to whether such Notes should be issued.
