

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, that a public hearing will be held before the Executive Director of the California Pollution Control Financing Authority (the "Authority") or a designee on Thursday, March 10, 2016, at 10:00 a.m. or as soon thereafter as such matters may be heard, in Room 440 of 915 Capitol Mall, Sacramento, California, on the proposed issuance pursuant to a plan of financing, of one or more series of revenue notes by the Authority in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$5,250,000 (the "Notes") on behalf of Tri-Cities Economic Development Corporation d/b/a Tri-CED Community Recycling (the "Company"), a California nonprofit public benefit corporation.

A portion of the proceeds of the Notes in an amount not to exceed \$3,723,579 is intended to finance the acquisition, construction, improvement, renovation, rehabilitation and/or installation of buildings, facilities and equipment, including trucks and other rolling stock, for the transport, handling, processing and/or recycling of solid wastes, to be located at 33377 Western Avenue, Union City, CA 94587, and to pay associated costs of the financing.

A portion of the proceeds of the Notes in an amount not to exceed \$1,526,421 will refund two prior series of the Authority's revenue notes issued on behalf of the Company in 2005 and 2007 (the "Refunded Bonds"). The Refunded Bonds were issued to finance similar costs as described in the prior paragraph, at the same location.

All financed assets are owned or will be owned and/or operated by the Company and/or an affiliate thereof.

Notice is further given that at said hearing, all proponents and opponents of the above referenced facilities or the possible financing will have an opportunity to be heard on the question as to whether such Notes should be issued.
