• ScholarShare Investment Board Staff Update

 Gloria Pulido - In late-January 2024, Gloria Pulido joined the ScholarShare Investment Board (SIB or Board) staff, filling a vacant staff services manager I (SSMI) position and is responsible for facilitating ongoing regional outreach and engagement strategies and efforts for SIB and its programs.

- Jose Quiaoit In early-March 2024, Jose Quiaoit joined the SIB staff, filling a vacant SSMI position and is responsible for the primary management of SIB's outreach team as well as other administrative, strategic, and oversight roles and duties.
- Maci (Rikka) Fisher In mid-March 2023, Maci (Rikka) Fisher joined the SIB staff, filling a vacant office technician position that serves as the primary support staff for SIB with various administrative duties and responsibilities.

• Morningstar Annual Ratings

As a follow-up from discussions that took place during the December 2023 SIB meeting regarding the Plan's 2023 Morningstar rating announced in early-November 2023, SIB staff has met with Morningstar to gather more details about the rating and analysis, and continues to evaluate the Plan, as well as ongoing ways to address the feedback received as needed to ensure the Plan offers the best offering to its participants. SIB staff plans to provide a strategic outline at the June 2024 Board meeting.

Proxy Vote

A joint special meeting of shareholders of Metropolitan West (MetWest) was held on February 15, 2024. With one (1) MetWest fund (Fund) included in the Plan, SIB has proxy voting rights on the proposal addressed at the meeting. In advance of the vote, SIB staff and Meketa, reviewed the proposal and Meketa provided a recommendation that included voting in favor of one proposal applicable to the Fund in the Plan. Following a review of Meketa's analysis and pursuant to SIB's Proxy Policy, the Chair, Chair's designee, and SIB's Executive Director voted in line with Meketa's recommendation and on behalf the Board pursuant to Resolution No. 2008-04 adopted by the Board in April 2008. The vote included favoring the proposal on the election of nine (9) trustees to the Board of Trustees of MetWest Funds.

• CalKIDS Financial Literacy Initiative

As an update, SIB continues to move forward in implementing various components associated with the development and implementation of financial literacy efforts associated with CalKIDS following the \$5 million ongoing appropriation initiated in the 2022-23 State Budget. The initial phase of this initiative includes the procurement of services associated with primary elements that include: website development, financial literacy tools, and development of targeted content (i.e., resources and videos) made available to families. The procurement of these services are in progress and SIB anticipates to executing many of them before of the end of the fiscal year, with remaining efforts to follow. SIB staff plans to provide an update at the next SIB meeting.
