

# Proof of Interconnection Application

- Different utilities have different methods for acknowledging receipt of an Interconnection Application
- Documentation provided by the contractor should contain the **property address** and the application ID
- Examples of valid documentation are provided in the following slides



# SDG&E: “Application has been processed” email



- An e-mail from [netmetering@sdge.com](mailto:netmetering@sdge.com) showing property address and application ID
- Utility will communicate that the application “has been processed” and is pending AHJ inspection
- Contractors can receive this notification prior to scheduling an inspection by the AHJ

Your application for interconnection has been received by SDGE's Customer Generation Team.

As soon as SDG&E determines that your request is complete and any required fees have been paid, the next step in the interconnection process is for your City/County to complete an electrical inspection. After SDG&E receives notification from your City/County that your system has passed inspection and no outstanding issues exist with your project, you'll receive an e-mail from us providing you with SDG&E's permission to operate (PTO) your Advanced Energy Storage system in parallel with our electric grid.

**\*\*\*\*\*Important Information About SDG&E Access Requirements\*\*\*\*\***

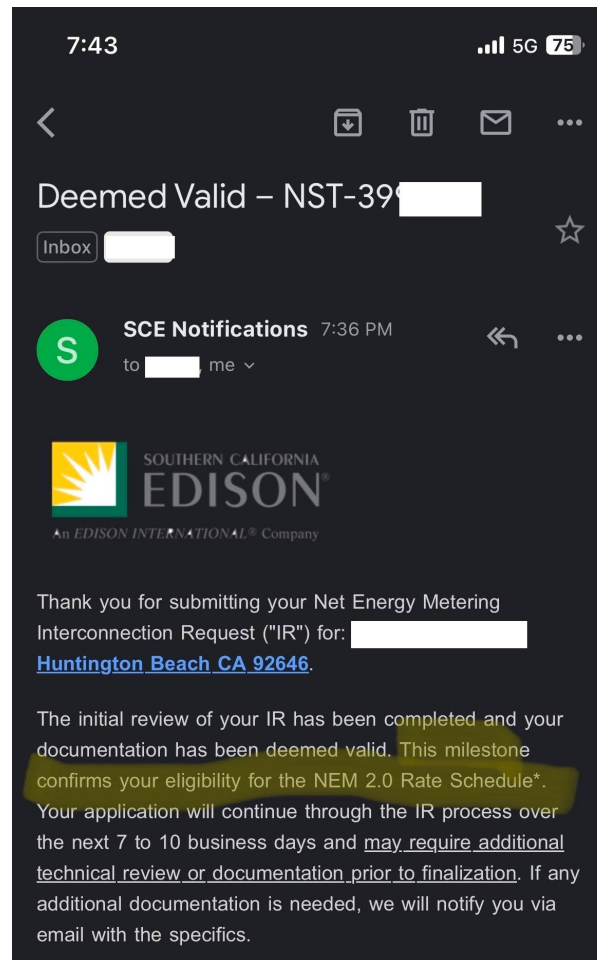
According to SDG&E's California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC)-approved [Electric Rule 16](#), Section 11, SDG&E must have the right to enter and leave your premises at any time for any purpose associated with furnishing electric service. As applicable, these rights include, but are not limited to:

- a. The use of a utility-approved locking device, if Applicant desires to prevent unauthorized access to utility's facilities;
- b. Safe and ready access for utility personnel, free from unrestrained animals;
- c. Unobstructed ready access for utility's vehicles and equipment to install, remove, repair or maintain its facilities; and,
- d. Removal of any and all of its property installed on Applicant's Premises after the termination of service.

# SoCal Edison: “Deemed Valid” email



- An e-mail from SCE Notifications showing property address and application ID
- Utility will communicate that the application has been “deemed valid” and will continue with review
- Contractors can receive this notification prior to scheduling an inspection by the AHJ



# PG&E: Application Summary PDF attachment

- Contractors will receive an email with subject line “PGE Interconnection Request Confirmation” and attached to that is an “Application Summary” PDF
- Property address must be visible on PDF (usually on first page – you can choose to send us only the first page, but its also fine/less work to send entire PDF)
- Contractors can receive this notification prior to scheduling an inspection by the AHJ
